Christopher L. Winters, DPM, has done research and worked with acellular matrices for more than 15 years.

He is a partner in the American Health Network, a multi-specialty group of more than 150 physicians in central Indiana.

He has also worked in a wound center at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana, since 2005.

He is the residency director of the podiatric medicine and surgery residency training program at the hospital.

He has participated in several clinical studies on wound care, which all have focused on lower extremity wounds caused by diabetes.

His poster about the Kerecis wound-treatment product, "A new piscine-derived acellular dermal matrix for difficult-to-heal wounds," has been accepted for presentation at the Symposium on Advanced Wound Care, San Antonio, Texas, this spring.

His articles on acellular matrices have appeared in *Advanced Skin Wound Care* and *International Wound Journal*.

He is board certified by the American Board of Wound Management as a Certified Wound Specialist-Physician (CWS-P), by the American Board of Multiple Specialties in Podiatry in the prevention and treatment of diabetic foot wounds, and by the Council for Medical Education and Testing in wound care.

He is a fellow of the American College of Clinical Wound Specialists and of the Academy of Physicians in Wound Healing.

He graduated from Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana, and from William Scholl College of Podiatric Medicine in Chicago, Illinois.
